(Didi replied, "You can stay in Shantivan but stay in this body"). I like Didi Nirmala very much! I don't know if she likes me or not! She has played a very good part here and overseas. She brings your donations to Shantivan for Baba. Just as I don't keep anything for myself, not 5 rupees or 5 pounds, I think all of you are the same – no-one keeps anything hidden away. All of you are family and you have big hearts. White clothes and empty pockets – yet we are the masters. Shiv Baba came in Brahma Baba and Brahma Baba sacrificed everything. This is how things are running.

I have always followed Baba's instructions – not manmat or parmat. Shrimat is always in my mind. Our job is to keep smiling. Baba asks us if there is anything so difficult that we can't smile>
