Sister Jayanti's question: In this morning's murli Baba said that when someone lives in a house they have to pay rent. So what rent would Shiv Baba pay Brahma Baba? Once Shiv Baba came into Baba, he didn't have to make effort. He didn't have to transform his intellect from being the father of 5 children to the father of unlimited children. Today Baba said he is the great-great-grandfather and he didn't know that so much was going to happen. Even Dadi Gulzar has said Baba pays her rent and therefore she doesn't feel the pain in her body as much. Dadi, you do some much service so what return does Baba give to you? You are tireless and you go to so many places, what return does Baba give you?

Dadi Janki:

We say Om Shanti 3 times and there are 5 virtues I remember.

I am also Baba's child and so are you His child. Baba says: Child, sit on My eyelashes. Baba, You have put me on Your eyelashes and taught me how to fly. To walk takes time.

Baba says: Here at every step there is income. We are so fortunate that at every step there is multi-millionfold income. We all have the ability to concentrate and it is easy to come together with concentration and stability. I would never say there is hard work in Raja Yoga. In order to claim that kingdom Baba has taught us how to fly.

Dadi has been here for 103 years but she still remembers the time that Shiv Baba came in Brahma Baba. In the whole of the cycle Baba has set us in His eyes. Heart, brain, eyes, whether brothers or sisters, check all 3 and see if they are working well.

Who feels it is easy Raja Yoga? I am not going to compare myself with others and see if others are happier than me. When people take pictures of Dadi, it is always the picture of Dadi blessing with her hands, because everything will always be alright for us.

The course pictures we have here we are good. We are the foundation of the tree and Baba at the top is an angel. Each one of you is different and unique. You cannot compare or say that that one is better than the other. Om shanti.
