When Dadi first came into knowledge, she never liked the concept of 'drama' and the fact that we would repeatedly have to get separated from Baba. It took a while before Brahma Baba was able to explain lovingly to Dadi the beauty of meeting after the long separation, and the fact that we will always be with Baba, despite being distant in our consciousness.

A true, *pukka* Brahmin is able to look at every scene of drama and accept that there is benefit in everything. We now know the three aspects of time and Baba is our Liberator and Guide, so there is no need to think unnecessarily about things or develop doubts about the self or drama.

Yesterday Baba told us to die alive: to live with the awareness that nothing is mine anymore and I act according to Baba's directions. Today Baba is teaching us how to speak to ourselves. Just imagine, we are listening and learning from the One whose teaching skills have no comparison in the entire world! Talk to yourself about all that Baba says, and then share it with joy and enthusiasm. You will find that there is no need to think or speak about anything else. The more you churn the knowledge, the more your face becomes cheerful and light.

Our only task is to drink nectar and give others nectar. We came to Baba extremely thirsty but it's Baba's wonder how He has made us so full that we are able to offer the nectar of knowledge to others. And, in doing so, we further empower ourselves, so that we become wells of nectar. A well has the unique characteristic of pumping water directly from the source, and providing fresh and clean water; so let me continue to quench the thirst of other souls by offering them this water/nectar of knowledge. Let me keep Baba and Mama constantly in the third eye, so that my life is one of happiness and contentment. No one should need to ask me whether I am happy or not - it should be apparent from my face and vibrations.
