

Amrit vela greetings from Dadi Janki on Sunday 29th December 2013

Om shanti. Good morning. Today is Sunday. What experience can I share? We sparkling stars are sitting with the Sun of Knowledge and the moon of knowledge. There is such a beautiful sparkle. There is light (prakash) in front of the Sun of Knowledge and at the same time, we are receiving a lot of sakaash. The moon makes us very cool. In the murli, when Baba tells us the contrast of the path of devotion and the path of knowledge, then we experience the contrast of the two paths to be wonderful. We were happy on the path of devotion. On the day of the full moon, we would hold a fast for the whole day, listen to the story of the true Narayan, and at night, we would only eat after having had a glimpse of the moon and it used to feel very good. The Brahmins would relate the story. On the path of knowledge, we have to become complete. Baba has observed such a big fast. So, seeing My children as the sparkling stars, people would ask: Who are they and whom do they belong to? They would continue to have visions. In the present murlis, Baba is reminding us of the visions that people used to have through Brahma Baba and now people are having visions of the Father through us children. It is such a beautiful scene. We forget everything else, and truly I don't remember anything else and there is great pleasure in this. Remembering the things that Baba tells us, we become absorbed in love through remembrance. Baba gives such love and remembrance ... Baba says: accept it. In order to accept it, look at the self to see how you are sitting. There is a pull on Sunday and Thursday to observe the discipline of meeting the family that has been created according to the drama. Today, I had a very good experience because it is through experience that we are able to see how Baba is working through our attitude and vibrations in a subtle way. When we listen to avyakt BapDada elevated versions, Gulzar Dadi repeatedly says: BapDada, BapDada, BapDada. We have such a meeting with BapDada at amrit vela and then throughout the day, there is just that one concern. OK.

It is a wonder of truth, love and faith. From the beginning until now, Baba has taught us how to use truth, love and faith at every second and in every breath in a worthwhile way. So, Baba – avyakt, sakar and incorporeal. The sakar is merged in the avyakt and what effort did Baba not make in order to make us avyakt from sakar. I saw with the eyes – with these eyes. The scene of Baba is in these eyes – not just to grant a vision, but truly Baba is merged in these eyes. Thank you Baba, thank you. Thank you to my family.

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
