FESTIVAL OF SHIV JAYANTI – THE DAY TO VOW SPIRITUAL REVOLUTION

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HERALDING DEITYISM:

GOD SHIVA REVEALS THE TRUTH RESULTING IN MAHA SHIVRATRI FESTIVAL

s every year, the devout Hindus would be celebrating Maha Shivratri on 7th March 2016. It is worth noting an article that appeared in The Times of India, Ahmedabad edition, by the name "Anamika: This Religion *Had No Name*", page 14th, on 4th February. Authored by Sri Chandrasekharendra Saraswatiji, and abridged from 'Deivatthin Kural' by Kanchi Periyaval, courtesy: Kanchi Kamakoti Peetam, the article takes the reader back to the origin of the "Hindu religion" and shares surprising facts about how the religion came to be. Some pertinent excerpts are shared below:

'We speak of the "Hindu religion", but the religion denoted by the term did not in fact have such a name originally. According to some, the word "Hindu" means "love"; others say a Hindu is one who

disapproves of himsa or violence. The term "Hindu religion" does not occur in any ancient shastra... The name "Hindu" was given to us by foreigners... However it may be, "Hinduism" was not the name of our religion in the distant past...Our basic texts do not refer to our faith by any name...

'Our religion predating all these (other religions) had spread all over the world. Since there was no other religion to speak about then it was not necessary to give it a name... Who was the founder of the Hindu religion? Was it Vyasa...or was it Krishna Paramatman... but both Vyasa and Krishna state that the vedas existed before them...are we to point to the rishis, the seers who gave us the vedic mantras, as founders of our religion? But they themselves declare: "We did not create the Vedas...It is true the Mantras

became manifest to the world through us... But the mantras were not composed by us but revealed by us. When we sat meditating with our minds under control, the mantras were perceived by us in space... We did not compose them (the seers are not mantra-kartas)...

'The sages saw them and made a gift of them to the world...In fact we must feel happy that we have the great good fortune to be heirs to a religion that is eternal.'

While accepting the bare truth from Sri Chandrasekharendra Saraswatiji's article, we further find ourselves fortunate to now be exposed to the Truth about the Supreme Being, as shared by Incorporeal God Shiva, and the three aspects of His creation in this Confluence Age. The main revelations are as follows:

▶ 1. God is One – God is Shiva, the Benevolent one, the eternal Creator.

- ▶ 2. The Creator establishes the Adi Sanatan Deity Religion (as the saying goes, God created Man in His own image). The age of worshipworthy deities followed the transformation from Kaliyug to Purushottam Sangam Yug, and then on to Satyug. During the age of Truth (Satyug), all the rulers and the ruled belonged to one Deity World Sovereignty, as there was no other religion and therefore no need to give any specific name.
- ▶ 3. All the elevated divine beings of Satyuga transformed their spiritual attributes at the Confluence Age into divine virtues, on the basis of the revealed truth about the Creator and His creation of Brahmins, through Prajapita Brahma. Those who make the most genuine, highest form of spiritual endeavours go on to become the image of the deities, Shri Krishna and Shri Radhe, who in their adult form are named Shri Narayan and Shri Lakshmi of the Golden Age.

Wherever the people of Bharat reside, they rejoice in celebrating Maha Shivratri, symbolic of God's reincarnation. On the path of Bhakti, there are many different stories connected with Maha Shivratri that herald the supremacy of God Shiva. However mythology is mythology, and reality can be revealed by no one else but the Divine Being, God Shiva, Himself. The manner of revealing the Truth is so unique: it occurs through divine visions, direct communication with human souls through the medium of Prajapita Brahma, and through the emergence of firm believers who follow God's teachings and aim to elevate their lives to the highest degree possible. Once a person understands the truth about the Divine Being, the three aspects of His Creation and transition from the most elevated stage: satopradhan to sato, rajo and tamo, she/he is motivated to become a loving, faithful child of the Supreme and elevate oneself to a god-like life.

There is a powerful domino effect at the end time of the Iron Age, the extreme depth of Kaliyug, when ordinary human beings become enlightened through spiritual wisdom as revealed by the Supreme, leading to them sowing seeds of righteous karma through which human souls are able to

return to their original pivotal purity, and reflect the worshipworthy deities of the Golden Age in their new 'avtar' or spiritual lifestyle. The transformation has been taking place for decades and is now becoming more evident from the lives of millions who have inculcated Godly teachings, and become courageous to conquer Maya (symbolic name for the five main vices) which is why the adage goes, "The conqueror of Maya becomes a conqueror of the World: Maya-jeet so Jagatjeet".

The best way to celebrate Maha Shivratri would be to reawaken our inner selves and live our lives as per the highest code of conduct (Shrimat) to become the real images of Shri Lakshmi and Shri Narayan. May Maha Shivrati celebrations this year mark the beginning of a new life for everyone so as to become enlightened instruments ofworld transformation! That would be the best way to praise and remember Incorporeal God Shiva on Maha Shivratri, and ensure that each and every moment thereafter becomes a life of celebration.

here is so much happiness and where does it all come from? Where did we learn how to smile? Fly on the flying carpet and don't come down.



Q: According to the present time it feels like the final moments are close so what kind of efforts do we need to make to constantly remain flying and enable others to fly?

This is everyone's desire to keep flying. Avyakt BapDada has given so much sustenance and there may be a few BKs who have taken sustenance from Brahma Baba too. I have taken this. My heart desires that just as I have drawn Baba's sustenance (I never asked for

sustenance from Baba), others can too. Now according to Drama, Avyakt Bapdada calls me on stage and whispers in my ears. Baba is on the right and on my left is fortune. What else is left? The heart, mind, intellect and resolves. Each one should ask: 'Is The Comforter of Hearts my companion?' As a detached observer, we see how good and easy the knowledge we receive is. There is no need to read or write too much...one should just remain introverted and always be happy and flying.

I have taken so much benefit from introversion. When we don't go into extroversion, we enjoy silence so much. I can see how everyone loves silence. The effort for success is the effort of the heart.

It is important to remain unshakeable and immoveable with no mischief or desires for anything. No comparison, dislike or jealousy. These things bring a great loss. We have to check our *drishti* in relationship to these vices. We must check our attitude and awareness closely. What do we keep in our

awareness? Do we hold on to whatever Baba has taught us or do we remember anything else? The strength of time is such that we receive the fruit of all the actions we perform. We receive fruit through karma and power through Yoga.

Effort makers are those who maintain attention on themselves and receive the benefit from this. During the last three years, Brahma Baba didn't come out of Pandav Bhawan gates. He would be either in his hut or his room and where the Tower of Peace is. He would take us for a walk. I remember this very well. We would have such great chitchat with Him. The office was outside where Ishu Dadi would sit and Baba would sit in a chair too. Dada Vishwa Ratan would often sleep out there. He was such a good protector of the home at that time. I am sharing this because even a little carelessness or laziness doesn't allow us to make good effort. One must never waste his/her time being lazy, or in going here and there. One must have heard what people say about

me....that I care, share and inspire.

I share what Baba has said. Baba has inspired me so much that the heart desires to keep the hand of Shrimat over my head. This hand is not heavy. Why do we experience heaviness? When we think about what is old and what has happened in the past. It is important to free oneself from this. We continue to study the teachings that God has given us. He has His hopes in us and we, His children, should use our time in a worthwhile way. Those who have surrendered their mind, body and wealth, their thoughts, words and actions will be elevated and express happiness. Beautiful things echo inside the mind.

I saw how Baba's stage remained unshakeable and immoveable despite having the responsibility of the Yagya. One day I was sitting on Mamma's bed and it was cold so I had a shawl around me, and Baba came in and asked, 'What are you doing, child?' I told him that I was sitting on Mamma's bed and feeling Mamma's stage in me.

The ones who prepare food are very fortunate. For the first five years in London, I would prepare the food. When Baba first gave me directions to go abroad, I first said "No" and then Baba with a lot of love, took me to class with Him. He then asked me in class whether I ever experienced sorrow. I looked at Him and with a lot of love told Him, "No, I don't receive sorrow or give sorrow." Then it doesn't matter what happens. As a detached observer, when we churn, reflect and think on things deeply, we can use Gyan....in our words, in the way we move, through our interactions and our behaviour. We need to receive and give respect. I saw Baba and Mamma do this in a practical way. I paid attention to my actions and relationships to such an extent that others should not feel heavy with me, especially those who I live with. Heaviness happens in our thoughts, words and actions so one should pay attention to all these three. Others should see that Baba is our Mother, Father, Friend, Teacher and Satguru. I have never said 'I am tired, or fed-up and I have never asked to be left alone. It doesn't matter what my state of health is, I am always happy to meet people. I stayed for 16 years in Pune and naturally did Yagya service there. I had such a deep desire to do yagya service and now I see others doing this.

Baba once went to Dilwala

Temple to see our memorial and a few days later he asked me to go and find 'my alcove'. I was very happy to hear it from Baba. Baba taught me such things that I can never forget. Wherever we do service, we should make sure that whoever makes food remembers Baba and offers *bhog*. One should never forget this.

Baba used to live an extremely simple life within Pandav Bhavan. During the 'beggary part', we had no grains at all and so the one in charge of the kitchen would wait until Dada Vishwa Ratan had been to the post office to see what money had been sent in the mail and food was cooked on the basis of this. Many left during this time, and I felt pity for them. Many souls even now don't have the aim to harmonise their traits. Let our interaction be based on honesty and love so that others may say that we are wonderful souls. We are wonderful because we don't speak waste, or listen to waste.

I can tell you about the wonderful efforts of the ancestor souls. I can give their introduction very well, as I knew them all. And I wonder why I am still in this body today and I ask Baba what is the point of keeping me in this body. Someone told me there is no

visa at the moment for me to go to the advance party. This is how they joke with me. Baba is the One who makes me move. How does He do this? It is so wonderful.

Let's smile in a natural way. Let the whole gathering smile. The *Yagya* is so huge now, including the kitchen. Yet in Pandav Bhawan the kitchen is still as it was in Baba's days. We should pay attention to be accurate with karma yoga as this is *yagya* service. Baba is happy and we are also happy. He is making us the knowers of the third eye, the knowers of the three aspects of time and the knowers of the three worlds.

This is the True Diwala Temple

When we touch our hearts we remember sweet Baba. Sweet Baba loves us and we love Baba. Each and every soul is very good. Baba loves and remembers everyone. How much love He has for us is seen in the *murlis*.

The more one has a soul-conscious stage, the more one has love for the one Father. Rajyoga is very easy yoga. We say Rajyoga, easy yoga. Most of us have seen the Dilwala Temple. Practically we are all sitting in the Diwala Temple. This is the true Dilwala Temple. It is wonderful. This Dilwala Temple is natural.

There are many wonderful things in the *murlis*. Baba speaks of being worthy of worship and worshippers. We are becoming worthy of worship. We must ask ourselves – are we becoming worthy of worship?

Baba has talked about doing service through the picture of Kalpa Tree

In the beginning Dadi was in Bombay and when Dadi was in her *loukik* home, her home was very small. The balcony was very small in size. In those days Baba asked Dada Vishwa Ratan to explain more about the Tree. There were many good souls who would come and listen and they would become happy.

While reading the *murli*, Dadi experiences extra happiness when Baba gives directions and they are being followed practically. Whatever Baba says is happening practically.

Everyone's heart says: Baba I will look at you always to mould my life.

In fact, the founders of these religions did not know that they had taken birth to establish a particular religion. They also did not announce to the world that they were establishing a religion. When we go into the philosophy and practice of these religions, we can understand that these founders had professed and preached certain values in life. For example, Islam professes the value of love, brotherhood, submission to God, abstinence, purity and worship; Buddhism professes the value of right views, right resolve, right conduct, right efforts and the aspiration to attain nirvana; Christianity professes the value of love, sacrifice, service, compassion, justice, faith, hope and charity; Sikhism professes truth, contentment, compassion, and spiritual discipline. It is also not clear that these values were the only values spelt out by the

here are many religions in the world. These religions have been founders have been either shed by individuals or are a by the names of the followers over the years.

In fact, during the lifetime of these founders, their philosophies were not accepted by the masses as a religion, instead they were chased and persecuted in many ways. These philosophies were accepted by a few people only after two or three generations. Ibrahim was not a Muslim, Jesus Christ was not a Christian, Buddha was not a Buddhist and Guru Nanak was not a Sikh. They were teachers of human kind who provided solace and succour to those who were suffering from persecutions of various kinds at their place of birth. These atrocities were based on blind faith and wrong belief systems existing in the society when they took birth at their respective places. These religions were founded with the soul power of those great souls but now stand divided and disintegrated into different sects and sub-sects and the values have also been distorted to suit to the

necessities and conveniences of the present day preachers.

Adi Sanatan – Ancient most – Deity Religion

The most ancient deity religion is the true religion of Bharat which is the oldest and the foundation of all other religions. Deities were the Kings, Queens and subjects of the Golden Age, when Sri Lakshmi and Sri Narayan were the Empress and Emperor of the world. During Copper Age, when the members of this religion came under the influence of vices, they were no longer eligible to be considered as belonging to deity religion hence came to be known as descendants of Sanatan -Ancient Dharma or later as Hindus. Moreover, the values which these souls cherished were distorted and perverted. Hinduism is not a religion as such but a term referring to a vast reservoir of ancient beliefs, practices, philosophies and traditions that originate and prevail in Bharat. It does not have an identified religious founder.

Ancient most deity religion was powerful because this religion was founded by the Supreme Soul God Shiva Himself at the end of Iron Age when unrighteousness and

irreligiousness reigned supreme. The first religion on the earth is founded by the Creator Himself. We all know that for any kind of advancement and progress in life, education is the basis. Hence, He teaches Spiritual Knowledge and Rajyoga Meditation and this becomes the basis for the establishment of Adi Sanatan Deity Religion. I had been having conversation with BK Shukla for some days. He gave me a book titled Seven Days Course. I took the book and read it thoroughly. I liked the book. THE GITA WAS SPOKEN BY GOD SHIVA

od Shiva is the Supreme Soul. He is the only Soul that is not subjected to birth and death. God Shiva's form is a point of oval-shaped conscient white light, incorporeal, imperishable and eternal. That is why He is remembered in the form of the 'Shiva Lingam'. He resides in Paramdham or Soul-World. Human souls are subjected to birth and death. Human beings come on earth to play their human part for at least one birth up to a maximum of 84 births, in a cycle that lasts exactly 5000 years.

Why does Shiva Incarnate?

God Shiva incarnates once at the end of every cycle to protect the virtuous, destroy irreligiousness and re-establish righteousness or dharma. By incarnating into the body of an ordinary human being renamed as Prajapita Brahma, Gop Shiva imparts the divine knowledge and teaches the original ancient Raja Yoga in order to reestablish the Brahmin clan and

then the deity dynasty of the Golden Age, ruled by Shri Lakshmi and Shri Narayan. This is fixed in the predestined eternal world drama that is cyclical and repeats itself identically every 5000 years.

When does Shiva Incarnate?

Shiva's incarnation takes place in the last 100 years of the cycle in kaliyug which period is called auspicious Confluence Age. Revelation of God's descent is in C4V7 of Gita quote "Arjuna, whenever there is decline of righteousness and irreligiousness is in ascendant, then I body Myself forth". It is important to note: He says to "body myself" and not to "take birth". This is referred to as Shiva's "divine birth" and is celebrated as Shiv Jayanti. Shiva's descent and incarnation at the end of the Iron Age is called Shivratri. God Shiva advises in chapter 4, and specifically verses 1-5 that this immortal ancient yoga was taught to, quote verse 5, "I taught this immortal yoga to Vivaswan,

the Sun-god, Vivaswan conveyed it to his son Manu who taught it to his son Ikswaku". He continues to advise that this yoga disappeared with the efflux of time and He descends once more to teach this "supreme secret to Vivaswan whose birth is at the beginning of creation".

Who is Vivaswan?

Vivaswan is Adi Dev Prajapita Brahma, whose next birth is that of Prince Krishna who is renamed Emperor Narayan, when he gets married to Radhe in the Golden Age or Sun dynasty. The Sun-god, also called "Surya Narayan", refers to the god Narayan of the sun dynasty. The Sun dynasty is the Golden Age or Satyug, just as the Moon dynasty is the Silver Age or Treta. Surya in this context does not mean the planet 'sun', it means the sundynasty. Shiva incarnated and 'bodied Himself' into Brahma to impart this immortal ancient yoga and the divine knowledge referred to as 'the supreme secret' in Gita c4v1-9. God says that when He incarnates, "a few out of millions and a few out of that few" recognize Him. His incarnation will receive great defamation because Ravan would have done an excellent job by creating confusion in casteism,

religion, languages, people as well as distribution of wealth and power. In the end of kaliyug, there will be innumerable religions and countless languages. He said that there would be great scepticism, doubts and suspicion and that the false prophets will be honoured instead of the genuine One. For it is written that "those with eyes will see and those with ears will hear".

The Kalki Avatar

According to the scriptures in the path of devotion, it is predicted that the last prophet to descend in the cycle would be called the "Kalki Avatar" and sometimes written as "Kalanki" or "eklang", which means defamation. He would be the spiritual freedom fighter to release humanity from the jail of Ravan, the chains of Maya and the grip of the vices. The kalki avatar is Prajapita Brahma.

Revelation of the Gita

The original, ancient, authentic Shrimad Bhagavad Gita was revealed by God Shiva when He incarnated into Brahma in the auspicious Confluence Age. Shiva spoke this Gita in the Confluence Age at the end of kaliyug, but it was written some 2500 years later in the Copper Age. This

makes the Gita the "Mother of all Scriptures" as Shrimad Bhagavad means the elevated versions of God. Shiva, through Brahma, destroyed the vices with the 'code of ethics' of the Gita and that was the condition for Krishna to be born in a pure world. Brahma followed "the pilgrimage remembrance of Shiva" as quoted in the Gita as "manmannabhav". This is easily the greatest mantra in the Gita that means to "fix your mind on Me" and it is the easiest method and path to attain liberation or mukti.

God Shiva and the Trimurti

In the path of devotion, God Shiva has been left out of the pictures depicting the Trimurti. The Trimurti includes Shiva and his three divine acts of Brahma as re-creator, Vishnu as sustainer and Shankar as transformer.

The Role of Brahma

Shiva creates and recreates through Brahma; that is why Brahma is referred to as the creator. Shiva transformed Brahma as the first Brahmin. All other Brahmins are mouthborn progenies created by Brahma through Shiva. The Brahmin clan is created and exists only in the Confluence Age.

The Role of Shankar

Deity Shankar is the transformer or destroyer of evil. His only function is to give inspiration to destroy the forces of evil and to assist in the purification and transformation of all souls and the restoration of the environment. Shankar is always shown in a meditative posture depicting his constant remembrance and having yoga with Shiva. This is why Shankar is always shown with a Shiv Lingam in the palm of his right hand. His clear message is that only the 'power of yoga' can burn the vices and remove the veil of Maya that has eclipsed the third eye. At the end of every chapter of the Gita, it gives the type of yoga required.

The Role of Vishnu

The third aspect of the Trimurti is the four-armed Vishnu whose function is to give sustenance to the austere souls. This is a very subtle aspect and must be clearly understood. Vishnu is the dual or combined form of Shri Lakshmi and Shri Narayan. The four arms represent the two arms each of both Shri Lakshmi and Shri Narayan. Therefore, Vishnu possesses both the masculine and feminine divine qualities, virtues and attributes of Shree Lakshmi and Shree

Narayan. Maha Lakshmi and Vishnu are but the same with different names and similar imagery.

The Complete Trimurti of Shiva

What is missing in the picture of the Trimurti in the path of devotion is God Shiva at the top of the picture as a point source of light spreading the divine rays of purity on Brahma, Vishnu and Shankar. This is the main reason that Shankar has been mistaken for Shiva.

God is not subjected to Birth and Rebirth in Gita

The devotees and lovers of the Gita must be immovable in their belief that God is not subjected to the cycle of birth and rebirth. God is 'abhogta' meaning that He is above the bondage of karma, nature and matter. Therefore, if God is 'abhogta', He surely does not have a mother or father nor does He ever take a human birth. In Gita c9v11, God tells Arjuna quote "Fools, not knowing my supreme nature, think low of Me, the Lord of creation who have put on the human body. That is, they take me, who have appeared in human garb through my Yogamaya (divine potency) for the deliverance of the world, to be an ordinary mortal".

God continues to advise in Gita c10 v3 quote, "He who knows me in reality as without birth and without beginning, and as the supreme Lord of the universe, he, undeluded among men, is purged of all sins". The Gita continues to point out to the devotees that God is never in human form quote Gita c7v24, "Not knowing My unsurpassable and un-decaying supreme nature, the unintelligent think Me, the Supreme Spirit beyond the reach of mind and senses, the embodiment of Truth, Knowledge and Bliss, to have assumed a visible human form".

expound on God form quote "Veiled by My Yogamaya, I am not manifest to all. Hence these ignorant folk do not recognize Me as the unborn and imperishable Supreme Spirit, that is, take Me to be subject to birth and death". Therefore, all the epithets in the Gita that refer to Krishna are but

the divine attributes of God Shiva who is the only One who can liberate mankind when trapped in the chains of Ravana. In summary, the name Krishna and the many other names in reference to Krishna in the Gita are epithets of God Shiva.

Shivratri and the Mahabharata War

The Mahabharata war took place in the Confluence Age. The Mahabharata war has a subtle part as well as a physical part. The conquest of the vices is the subtle part done through the pilgrimage of remembrance or yoga. The physical part is through nuclear wars, plagues, pestilence and natural calamities. Shivratri signals the beginning of the Mahabharata War.

Shivratri is the most important event in world history, yes world history, as this signifies the transformation of the old *Kaliyugi* world to the new world or the Golden Age. God Shiva establishes the deity religion of 'Sanatan Dharma' now called the 'Hindu Religion'.

BELIEF IN IMMORTALITY OF SOUL GETS STRONGER!

ore and more people realise that they are more than their physical bodies. Although in schools, we are taught that we're just the activity of carbon and some proteins that live for a while and die later, not all scientists are prepared to follow this materialistic teaching.

Biocentrism – a new 'theory of everything' - challenges this traditional, materialistic model of reality and presents five scientific proofs that convincingly prove that there is something immaterial that survives bodily death. (http:// www.robertlanzabiocentrism.com/ *five-reasons-you-wont-die/*) One of the five proofs is the application they make with the famous First Law Thermodynamics (that energy cannot be created or destroyed but can be changed from one form to another). This irrefutable Law shows that physical body would disintegrate one day, but the 'me' feeling which is just a cloud of energy in one's head, doesn't go away at death. It is the immaterial. immutable, and ultimate

animating principle that exists independent of the body. Interestingly, Thomas Alva Edison who developed many devices (such as the motion picture camera, and electric light bulb, phonograph...) was so sure about the existence of immortal soul that he was actually on an unfinished ambitious project of developing a device, a sort of 'spirit phone' that could communicate with the spirit world, according to a nearly lost chapter of Edison's memoirs republished in France in the first week of March 2015 (Times of *India*, March 7, 2015)

Another stunning support comes from some prominent former non-believers. Dr. Michael Newton is a globally acclaimed Past Regression Therapist who heads the Newton Institute for Life between Lives Hypnotherapy (www.newtoninstitute.org) which trains Past Regression Therapists from all over the world. When he started Past Regression Therapy (treating the diseases rooted in the past lives),s he could experience firsthand the great truth that souls

only change bodies, but never die, and also became a believer in God who is "with capabilities immensely superior". His conviction comes from case histories of over 70,000 persons who could recall their past-life memories. He writes: "I see the soul as an intelligent light energy. This energy appears to function as vibration wave similar to electromagnetic force but without the limitations of charged particles of matter. The soul energy does not appear to be uniform. Like a finger print, each soul has a unique identity." (Destiny of Soul, page 85) Dr. Brian L Weiss MD, Chairman Emeritus of Psychiatry at the Mount Sinai Medical Centre in Miami, was a Jew who never believed in the immortality of soul, but when he saw his patients giving evidence of past lives, he too not only accepted this belief but also started a Training Institute (www.brianweiss.com) that trains PR Therapists. Today, there is greater interest shown in this field with lots of PR Academies coming into existence worldwide.

Another prominent atheist, Dr. Ian Stevenson (who was director of the Division of Personality Studies at the University of Virginia) later not only turned a believer in the

immortality of soul but also became a strong advocate of reincarnation, documenting over 3,000 cases of children who remembered their past lives. While Ian Stevenson collected proofs from the East, Dr. Jim Tucker, Associate Professor of Psychiatry and Neurobehavioral Sciences at the University of Virginia School of Medicine, presented proofs from the West in his book "Life Before Life: A Scientific Investigation of Children's Memories of Previous Lives HYPERLINK "http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/ Life_Before_Life"s." He suggests that Quantum Mechanics may offer a mechanism by which memories and emotions could carry over from one life to another.

Though all these provided irrefutable proof from East and West. modern neuroscientists were reluctant to accept the truth about the soul. But Dr. Eben Alexander himself (a Harvard educated NEUROSURGEON, who has worked at Harvard Medical School and was always sceptical about after-lifeexperiences) changed his beliefs when he himself had a similar experience after going into a coma, and it became international news. Newsweek Magazine (October 8, 2012)

published even a cover-story on his conversion. He too started own organization **HYPERLINK** "http:// eternea.org/"ETERNEA (http:/ /eternea.org/) to provide "convincing evidence that the continuity of consciousness is true and that the survival of the soul is real". There are many scientific books presenting convincing evidence for the survival of consciousness beyond the physical death of the body. To mention a few: Irreducible Mind: Toward a Psychology for the 21st Century" (co-authored by Edward F. Kelly, Ph.D., Emily Williams Kelly, Adam Crabtree, Alan Gauld, Michael Grosso, and Bruce Greyson. Lanham, MD: Rowman & Littlefield); "Science and the Near-Death Experience" Science and Psychic Phenomena, and Science and the Afterlife Experience: Evidence for the Immortality of Consciousness (by Chris Carter http:// www.scienceandtheafterlife experience.com/) which reveals 125 vears documented scientific studies. No wonder, great minds like William Shakespeare rightly admitted we are more than our physical bodies: "What a piece of work is a man! How noble in reason, how infinite in faculty!

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In form and moving how express and admirable! In action how like an angel, in apprehension how like a god!" (*Hamlet*, Act 2, Scene 2, Page 13)

Bible declares in no uncertain terms that "eternity" exists in man. (Ecclesiastes 3:11) Interestingly Jesus, through a vivid picturisation (Luke 16:19-31) not only illustrated the survival of soul (with its attendant teaching of Law of Cause and Consequence) but also declared that John, the Baptist, was the reincarnation of ancient prophet Elijah (Mathew 11:14; 17:1-13) and even spoke, in front of his disciples, to the souls of ancient prophets Moses and Elijah who left their mortal coils centuries before. (Mark 9:2-4)

Interestingly, the very first thing Bhagavat Gita highlights is this fundamental truth that each one is a unique soul, housed in a body which is a temporary residence. "Just as the Atma (soul) acquires a childhood body, a youth body and an old age body during this life; similarly, it acquires another body after death. The Atma is not destroyed when the body is destroyed. Just as a person puts on new garments after discarding the old ones; similarly, the Atma acquires new bodies

after casting away the old bodies (2:13, 20,

Benefits of knowing who you are

- ▶ The greatest benefit of believing we are souls (immortal spirit beings) functioning through physical bodies is that it gives us freedom from the greatest fear—fear of death.
- ▶ It makes the people responsible. This would help us treat others humanely, prevent us from increasing environmental devastation, basification of the ocean etc.
- ▶ More importantly, it helps us to be spiritual. Just like the word ashok (a + shok)means "without sorrow," the word atma ("a" + "tama") means "without andhakar (darkness)", or ahankar (ego, sense of doership)" the root of which is ignorance (darkness). Interestingly, Bhagavat Gita says sanatana dharma (eternal duty) of an atma is to "attach itself with the Supreme Soul ALONE and to take delight in the welfare of ALL beings." (Gita 18:66; 12:2, 4, 20) Shiv Baba, in the Confluence Age, goes a step ahead of Bhagavat Gita and says sanatana dharma of atma is "to always remember HIM and always do things that elevate and purify self and others." (Murli 24.07.2015; 7.8.2015)

When one realizes that he is *atma* functioning through this body, his enjoyment would be in living in harmony with that newfound-truth and in manifesting *atma*'s qualities—nothing else will be an attraction to him, as drainage water would not be an attraction to one who has access to abundant supply of honey.

THE FILTRATION PROCESS IN THE SOUL

The mind and its creation i.e. thoughts, in these times, in most people, are controlled by three main factors:

- 1. Their habits or personality traits
- 2. Their past experiences, and

3. Information which they are exposed to and which they imbibe.

The intellect is like a filter which has the function of discriminating, of judging the thoughts and deciding which ones to put into practice and which ones not to, basically filtering them. Presently the filter of the intellect has become weakened, confused and unsure; it has become blocked by many incorrect beliefs, due to which this filtration does not take place properly – as a result many wrong thoughts get converted into actions. A lot of times during the day, thoughts become actions so fast, that the filter of the intellect does not even come into play i.e. thoughts become actions bypassing the filter.

The beliefs that we have today are related to our cultural, physical, social, religious, political identity associated with our age, gender, occupation, wealth, role etc. of our body. Beliefs connected to materialism, to having rather than being, are living based on the perception of the sense organs, and not on the intuition and the wisdom of the spirit. There are beliefs that block you, or brake you, others break you; they bring about fears in you and a limited perception of reality and of yourself. However much you try to generate positive thoughts, if you do not change these beliefs, their influence on the intellect will be so strong that it is almost impossible to maintain a positive state of mind. Even if you experience it, it will be short-lived and temporary.

COP21 (A Conference of the Parties) AND MORAL VALUES

'Becoming simple and to have a simple life with moral values are needed to make some meaningful changes in climate' –B.K. Sis. Jayanti at 'Paris Climate Conference (COP21)'.

he COP 21 UN Frame work conventions on climate change was organized in Paris with 195 participating countries, some 140 heads of state, in addition to representatives of business and commerce, civil society organisations, religious leaders, the scientific community and political parties besides spokesperson of indigenous people and those who live on islands under threat of potential inundation due to sea level rise. Despite the fact that climate summits do resemble an annual ritual since the first 1972 UN Stockholm summit yield little or no results except broadening our understanding of the issue or creating some public awareness that we should save ourselves from our own excesses.

According to the World Metrological Organization, greenhouse gas levels in the atmosphere reached a record high in 2014 and relentless fuelling of climate change is endangering the planet for future generations. The statistics in climate change could push more than 100 million people into extreme poverty by 2030 by disrupting agriculture and fuelling the spread of malaria and other diseases. The report highlighted that the world's poor are woefully unprepared to deal with climate shocks such as rising seas or severe droughts. UN agency WMO showed levels of carbon dioxide, the main greenhouse gas, climbing steadily towards the 400-parts-per million(ppm) level, having hit a reliable record every year since 1984. Carbon dioxide levels averaged 397.7 ppm in 2014 but briefly breached the 400-ppm threshold in the northern hemisphere in early 2014, and again globally in early 2015.

At home in India the situation is more grievous and horrific. Our Prime Minister said in the inauguration of the Indian

Pavilion at Paris summit that "climate change is not our making, it is the result of global warming that come from an industrial age powered by fossil fuel". Most of our metro cities like Delhi, Mumbai, Kolkata have erroneous level of poisonous metals in air. In Mumbai, the vulnerability of 'Super-storm' is greater than in New York. Here, climate change has a direct impact on farmer suicides, and Naxal violence. A major Columbia University study shows that in India where drought advances, so do Maoists. The so called "Red corridor" comprised Bihar, West Bengal, Odisha, Chhattisgarh and Andhra Pradesh witnessed intensification of Naxal violence as drought situation worsened. It is estimated that nearly 12% of the land in India is prone to flood and river erosion, more than half of its coastline is susceptible to cyclones and Tsunamis. The Chennai floods are related to El Nino changes which can be traced back to climate change. Climate change caused a cotton crop infestation in Punjab and is already contributing to social unrest there.


Currently, there are three ways of combating climate change. The first way, which is the focus of traditional climate talks, involves reducing emissions of greenhouse gases.

But since we have let emissions grow for decades, it will be all but impossible, using this approach alone. A second way involves planetary geoengineering, for example, by injecting sulphur into the stratosphere to cool earth's surface. Fundamental objection to geo-engineering is that it has nothing to address the root cause of the problem. The third way is to develop moral values and sense of responsibility among the citizens of the world. Evidently the problem is mainly due to lack of sense of responsibility, lack of respect and sensitivity and lack of sense of duty towards other fellowbeings. The problem of environmental pollution is in fact nothing but mental pollution. As such, it would not be wrong to point out that the main problem is the problem of wrong human behaviour, wrong attitudes of man and his inadequate and improper emotional quotient. The degeneration of moral and spiritual values, has left administrators with problem of randomness, uncertainties, indeterminacy and ambiguity. Decision-makers have to do continuous contingency planning and have to modify their plans every now and then. These continuous uncertainties make people less confident in their government and the

governments feel pestered by serious fluctuations in human behaviour. Such kind of instability was witnessed shortly before when in national news channel the anchor asked a question to the panel consisting political leaders, environmentalists etc. about the solution of abnormal rate of heavy metals in Delhi's air. Instead of finding the real solution, they started to pass the buck and the entire debate ended by beating about the bush. This clearly implies the ignorance, frustration and lack of moral responsibility of leaders in general and public at large.

We need to turn within, take stock of ourselves, formulate our own ethical policy and adopt a micro level course of action regarding the use environment and natural resources. Degradation of the environment mirrors the quality of our collective consciousness and values. Pollution of the external atmosphere reflects our mental attitudes. Individual transformation is the key to redressing the unbalanced state of nature. We need to take responsibility for living and thinking according to the natural principles of human values. This is only possible when each of us empowers ourselves through meditation and spiritual study. We need to reconsider our priorities and values and transform the way we think. Attitudinal change is essential. Individuals are as connected to one another as are earth, wind, fire and water. People start to feel personally responsible for environmental degradation when the intangible connections become clear.

How much should a person Excessive consume? consumption of the natural resources by the name of industrialization is another example of fragmented moral values. Due to the inadequacy of moral and intellectual values, we have always ignored the consequence of climate change. We have to understand that as climate change deepens, extreme weather events will intensify, and the polar ice caps will melt causing sea levels to rise. Over time, cities will be repeatedly flooded, from excess rainfall and rising sea levels. Several big cities will go under water more or less simultaneously, to the point that recovery will be impossible. They will simply have to be abandoned. The global warming apocalypse is upon us. So, it is important to maintain an environment friendly lifestyle, values and principles and make contact with likeminded people and organizations that have a commitment to the environment.

DON'T BE CARELESS



n the Gita, God said to Arjun: 'You do not know about your own births, but I know. You are the one who comes into the cycle of death and birth, and so you do not know about your births. I know about all your births, because I am beyond birth and death.' Only the One who does not come into this cycle, can know about everyone's births. One who takes births comes down, and so as he continues to take births, he forgets. The Father says: 'I don't come in the cycle, so I don't forget. I have knowledge of everyone. Only one who has knowledge of the whole cycle, can explain that knowledge. One will give what one has. And so I'm called the Ocean of Knowledge, Ocean of Peace, Ocean of Happiness. I come and show the way of peace and happiness, so I am praised.' All these things must understood.

The Father tells us – don't be careless. Today, the entire world is in carelessness. We were also careless before. It isn't that we have come from above; we also belong to this world. But now, having received the light of



Knowledge from the Father, we have understood the things accurately, When the Father is telling us accurate things, we should pay attention.

Despite listening and understanding, if we are still careless, it is like being a great fool. One should not become that. The Father says: 'Children, understand all these things and continue to increase your efforts.' Time is now little, and even of that little time, little is left. As a great many days have passed, so the lifespan continues to reduce. Even in devotion it is said: 'Look how foolish the human is – he thinks he is growing, but doesn't understand that as he grows, his life becomes shorter.' Check Yourself

Before destruction, at least we should prepare something for the future. We should also see: Am I ready? If I were to breathe my last now, have I earned something? Do I have accumulated stock of spiritual earnings? One should take care of one's spiritual stock. One must understand that if one leaves his body now, he will again take birth, and take the knowledge again i.e. begin from the scratch. The Father says: 'Whatever you want to take from Me, take it now - take it in this very birth.'

One must also realize that if one were to die now and take birth again, it will take him at least 15-16 years to be able to listen to this Godly knowledge and understand it well. Even if one acquires knowledge in childhood, it will take time to imbibe it and to become complete and perfect. How will one find so much of time? One has to work hard for this. One needs time to be perfect and complete even after receiving knowledge. Is it that one gets ready in a day? We have the

burden of sins of many births on our head; we need time to clear that.

One Who Does Good Receives a Good Return

The Father says: 'This is your last birth in which you have to take this divine knowledge so you have to be careful that if you leave the body before destruction, you have enough stock.' If I leave this world, can I claim the complete birthright from the Father? The time to claim this is now. Make efforts, pay good attention, and claim your rights. We are awake now, whilst people in the world are asleep, so we shouldn't be careless like them. Those who are awake, have their eyes open. Those who have their third eye open, those who have received the light of knowledge, have to be very careful and cautious. One must understand these aspects, make good efforts, and receive good fruit. So, all that one needs to do is to get the knowledge of good and bad. Those who do good will get good. Therefore, following the elevated advice of God Shiva, one must purify oneself: remove all the evils, and do good.

People speak of purifying water so that they mightn't be afflicted by diseases. There, they purify the water; here we have to purify the soul. We catch diseases from impure things – so people in the world give purified water. Today, they have so many machines; they labour so hard to purify water. The Father says, the soul also needs to be purified. If it is dirty, it cannot go back to its Soul World along with God Father Shiva. Which is the machine to purify the soul? Knowledge and yoga. In the world, people have to spend so much money to purify water. We are getting purified without any expenses; and we get everything purified in Heaven. The elements, water, earth, air, everything will be pure and in perfect order.

Make Efforts with Complete Understanding

Many times when we get something easily, or cheap, we do not value it. The Father is giving us such a great and elevated knowledge very easily; so we must value it. We must ask ourselves, 'Am I moving along in this spiritual journey in a slack, lazy, careless manner? We should stop lethargy. This is for our own benefit.

It is easy to make efforts if we realize that the One who is giving us this knowledge and teaching Rajyoga is the Supreme Father. Can a father make his children labour hard? Different saints or gurus showed us a very difficult and hard path to attain God but none of those practices helped us connect with the Supreme.

The Father says: 'Though they have done something in the name of God, they also turned devotees away from Me, saying God is omnipresent. Still, I will give them the short-term fruit of their efforts. But here I give the fruit directly, and for the longterm. Moreover, accurate liberation and salvation is received through Me only. For this, you have to burn your sins completely by putting your utmost efforts. Receive power from Me and burn sins completely, only then can you claim the inheritance of liberation and salvation. I have to come to give the knowledge and yoga which you need for this purpose.

People today cannot live without satisfying themselves with their bad habits. Many have the habit of being bad behind closed doors.

od has graced me with a keen interest in writing since my college days. Many of my personal experiences I often share with my friends and colleagues through various media. Personal experiences give the readers a clear idea as to how spirituality can be made an integral part of our life.

Once I had an opportunity to participate in a three-week Management Development program in 1993 while working as an executive in National Insurance Company Ltd. This program was held at National Insurance Academy (N.I.A.), Pune which is an institute of higher learning established especially for training the officers of insurance sector.

We were about thirty officers

from the four public sector insurance companies. The training program consisted of various sessions aimed at developing the art of elocution, **Inter-personal** skills, handling various lifesituations etc. One part of the training contained Human Resources Development, **Breaking Communication** Barriers. and Selfempowerment etc. I tried to include spirituality in some of the sessions and found it to be quite effective. Some of my colleagues liked the spiritual methods and even the trainers appreciated their positive effect.

One day one of the trainees asked me, 'Ranjit, tell us in simple terms what is meditation'? I replied in short, 'When the cells of a battery are discharged, we need to recharge them. Likewise when the soul exhausts its power, it needs to be re-charged, which can be done by linking the soul with the Supreme Soul. This mental link with God is meditation.'

Through the practice of Rajyoga we can become soulconscious which makes us impartial, honest and efficient. The transparency at practical level manifests itself in our harmonious relations with our colleagues, friends and family members. In one of the sessions I spoke on the power of positive thinking, meditation and Godly grace. At the end of the session, some of the participants showed keen interest in meditation. I gave them elementary books on meditation. In the evening, when we were free, several of us used to sit in entertainment room and play meditation songs which we also enjoyed singing in chorus.

We also planned a cultural program one evening which included a quiz contest wherein the entire staff of the training centre and their families participated. We also involved the children and students in Quiz contest and the cultural program. The positive and harmonious effect of these

initiatives was very much liked by the staff and their families. Some spiritual songs of the Brahma Kumaris were also played and performed at during the program. Many souls got divine message on the occasion.

'At the end of the training program, Sh. Ashok Wadikar, our trainer and coordinator, informed that there would be 'Asking for a Gift' session. He said that during the course of three weeks we would definitely have observed certain qualities and virtues in our colleagues. Each one of us had to ask for a quality as a gift from the colleague in whom we observed it. 'When you ask for a gift (virtue) from the fellow trainee, it will automatically be given to you,' Sh. Wadekar further commented.

The training program filled us with new energy and selfconfidence. On my return journey, I traveled by Rajdhani Express from Pune to New Delhi. The other lady had her seat just adjacent to my seat. I asked her to have rest, offering her sufficient space on the seat. I told them that I was returning from a training program. bout 2500-year old Patanjali Kriya Yog promised that a practitioner shall conquer graying of hair, dim vision due to cataract, ageing process and diseases. This shall ensure a state of Samadhi or Kaivalya which simply means liberation from the pain and sufferings of all kinds. In short, the belief that a practitioner's soul shall merge into and dissolve into Divinity is a mere myth or purposeful misinterpretation. Each soul is indestructible and undergoes repeated cycles of births and deaths. This reality has been explained by the incorporeal Supreme Soul through the human medium of Prajapita The esoteric Brahma. knowledge disseminated by the Supreme Soul is called *murli* which is the divine message read at each of 8500 BK-Centres in the world. The *murlis* always emphasise on unshakable belief and faith on Shrimat, i.e., Commandments from the Supreme soul. Sage Patanjali also told that the benefits from Kriya yog could be obtained only when the kriya is done with total

trusting surrender to the Divinity – Ishwar Pranidhan.

Can Faith move Mountains?

Belief and faith can literally move the mountain. An American study has discovered that in the present times even the placebos (non-medicinal substances giving cure) have become 70 to 300 times more powerful than the drug itself if the patient has total belief and faith in the treating doctor. This finding has made several drug companies to shut their business. It is most unfortunate that today the patients do not have any faith in the treating doctor. Usually most of the educated ones go to Google to confirm if the doctor had given them proper medicine. The uneducated persons put in a blind belief and faith in a doctor whose heart is not pure and usually is affected by greed. Loss of belief and faith is responsible for transforming a noble healthcare profession into a five star common business. No wonder, the God-like doctor faces criminal assaults today. Another American study has shown that the patients never file legal proceedings against a doctor who spends at least 10 minutes of time in talking to them and listening to them. Most commonly, robotic doctors of today dispose of the patients mechanically. Empathy is often absent. The most common reason is the huge loans the doctors have to take for their education in a private medical college and for setting up the practice.

How are belief and faith created?

Roger Sperry discovered in 1970 that man has one brain but two minds. The scientist mind in the dominant hemisphere of the brain is judgmental, a seat of negativity and full of doubts and suspicion. It demands scientific proof for developing belief and faith. The other hemisphere has spiritualist mind which functions on belief and faith. This is the quickest way to progress. With belief and faith, one can find God Himself. But scientist minds spend millions of dollars to discover one God's particle.

Scientist mind does linear thinking, i.e., it learns by reading, seeing and listening. This creates a temporary memory. Spiritualist mind is 'Experiential'. It learns its lessons from 'Experiences'. Such learning is life-long. Thus 'experience' is known as the best teacher. Then acquiring a skill becomes automatic, accurate and easy. Remember

the troubles you had while learning to drive a car. Once the 'Experience' becomes embedded in the subconscious, all the troubles disappear.

Beliefs are the Cause of Habits

Belief and faith are created by the 'Experiences' or inputs from parents, friends, reading and other means of gaining knowledge. The inputs form thoughts, emotions and desires which are recorded as transient images across a virtual screen called Mind. When a particular bad thought forms repeatedly in the mind, under propitious circumstances, it results in Bad karma. Repeated Vikarma gives rise to habit. A long standing habit becomes one's nature. The perception, attitude, belief, faith and behavioral patterns are decided by Vrutti. Buddhi or wisdom resides in Gyanvigyanmaya kosh of the body. This is the famous 'Inner voice' which shouts the loudest initially in protest but becomes progressively weak when the habit is continued. Once this happens, the person seeks immediate gratification of his desires. This is how addictions like smoking are formed. **Improper** inputs from surroundings then strengthen the belief that smoking is something great. Once the vrutti becomes

hardened, it is passed on to the next birth through the Traits (*Sanskara*). The traits thus could be called the virtual genome of a soul or *Atman*. The traits form the *karmik* account for the soul. This account, of bad, means diseases, pain and sufferings in life. If good, then all the good things in life become a person's birthright. It is at this point of time that a lifestyle of a yogi or a spiritualist becomes important.

Three Pillars of a Yogi Life

Three pillars of Yoga are Simaran or God's remembrance, Satsang or the elevated company, and Seva or service unto mankind. Remembrance of the Supreme soul with single pointed focus of thought (Ekagra chitta Avastha) becomes Simaran. Attending the Divine Muralis read at all the Brahma Kumaris centres in over 140 countries becomes Satsang. Passing on the Message of God to the ignorant brethren becomes service seva. In fact, the Muralis are the empowering food for soul, a charging of the discharged battery of the soul. Dr Naras Bhatt, an American cardiologist, calls this cosmic energy as Cosmic Healing Vibrational Whisper. Aura scanner is able to demonstrate this 'Cosmic Energy' traversing

He bestowed the knowledge of the soul to the human beings who were considering themselves to be mere bodies. Whoever learnt that lesson, shaped their lives accordingly, and also made an effort to transform the world of sorrow into a world of happiness i.e. Heaven. People, who were ignorant and didn't pay attention to the Godly teachings, kept on performing misdeeds. They prepared arms through which they paved the way for the destruction of the human clan. But this destruction was a blessing in disguise because most of the vicious human beings died and the atmosphere on the earth got rid of its impurity and negativity. And the next generation that was born, was full of very elevated and virtuous human beings having, pure vibrations; the earth then looked like Paradise/Heaven. The human souls (people) who used to behave like devils because of their demoniac propensities, got transformed into divine beings by emerging their divine traits and qualities and were called deities. Thus, through the reincarnation of God, the Supreme Soul, God Shiva, the entire world underwent a big metamorphosis. Not only this, women themselves are selling their bodies as if it is a commercial commodity. Discipline is found wanting in every field. Stress has become a common thing in everyone's life. Therefore, this is the

appropriate time for the Supreme Soul, the Supreme Father, God Shiva to incarnate on the earth to uplift the human beings.

The Good news is that He has already come and has been performing His task of teaching Rajyoga, and uplifting people since 1936.

The Divine Message of God Shiva

The message that Supreme Soul, God Father Shiva is conveying to all the souls is that self-oblivion is the core of all the problems of an individual and the society. Transforming the human beings from being self-oblivious to having knowledge of the self is the very aim and objective of the Spiritual Revolution proclaimed by God Shiva. By knowing what He is, His attributes, and by remaining in His remembrance, we can recognize our own form of being a soul, and re-connect with the virtues lying dormant within the soul. This is the very message of this great festival for the whole human society, accepting which in the context of the current circumstances and imbibing the same in our conduct is for our own benefit. Therefore, on this Shivratri festival, let's all take a vow that we'll shed the bodyconsciousness and will remain in soul-consciousness, thereby emerge our divine qualities. In order to enable others to reach this stage, we'll dedicate ourselves to this divine service for the humanity and thus take part in this Spiritual Revolution created by the Supreme Father, God Shiva, for the World benefit.
