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## **God Realization**

In this world, many beliefs exist about God. As a result, people understand God in their own way and often in their own imagination. But what is required is the understanding God as He is, what He is and how He is. The correct understanding about God has to be given by God Himself!

There are some who don't believe in the existence of God, often the reason being His existence cannot be proved like that of human beings. But because we cannot see God with the gross eyes, it doesn't mean that God doesn't exist. Just like wind, which cannot be seen but can be very much felt, it is possible to experience God's presence through Godly knowledge and meditation.

# Who is God and what is His form and name?

We shall now try to understand who God or the Supreme Soul is. The term 'Supreme Soul' means He is supreme among all souls. It implies that, He is also 'a soul', though He is the Highest of all. He is above birth and death. God is the Supreme Father-Mother, Supreme teacher and Supreme Preceptor to all the human beings and He himself has no father-mother, teacher and preceptor.

God is a subtle, infinitesimal point of Light. He is not visible to the naked eye but it is very much possible to experience His presence and proximity in meditation. He is incorporeal in the sense that he does not have a body of his own. He is not a human being nor does He have a human form. He is immune to pleasure and pain unlike human beings.

Names are a means of identification of human beings after they are born. They do not speak of qualities and actions of the person; they are simply proper nouns and are not attributive names. But the

name of the supreme soul or God is based on His qualities and actions. His self-revealed name is 'Shiva'. 'Shiva' means doer of good or benefactor. God does good to all and therefore He is called Shiva. All souls ask for salvation and beatitude i.e. peace and happiness from Him. People remember Him by many other expressive names.

#### **His Virtues:**

God is the Supreme Father of all. He is called the creator. He is oceanic in his virtues - the ocean of peace, the ocean of love, the ocean of bliss, the ocean of knowledge, the ocean of happiness, the ocean of mercy, etc. He is the truth. He is the Almighty and Authority. He is reputed to be the preserver or sustainer of virtues and the destroyer of all evils. He is also the liberator, the guide, and the bestower of salvation, therefore the sadguru. He dispels sorrow, bestows joy. God is perfect in all ways and absolutely detached and loving. He is very benevolent and helpful and so souls ask all things of him. When in sorrow and losing all hope, souls turn to him intuitively and inevitably.

Many are the religions and paths that souls take in their quest for reaching God. Many wars have been waged in his name. However, he does not exclusively belong to anyone. He belongs to everyone equally.

#### The Supreme Father of all Souls:

God is the father of all souls in this world. It is observed that all religions have images, idols or memorials bearing one name or another to represent the form of Light that God is. All over India, the images of the form that Shiva has is found installed; these images are without any human form, in the form of linga, which is the symbol of an incorporeal Being. # **Leadership Qualities**

In order to be a successful manager, one has to be an effective leader. The difference between a manager and a leader is that the manager stays at the back and pushes people into the system, while a leader stands in the front and pulls the people along with him. The manager administers and maintains, while a leader innovates and develops. The manager relies on systems and counts on controls while a leader relies on people and counts on their trust. As such the manager enables things to be done right, while a leader does the right things through inspiration.

Hence, the organizational world demands leaders not just managers. Who is a true leader? Somebody has beautifully defined a leader as "One who never reacts, but observes, understands, analyses and then acts decisively". He would not react immediately on small things because he has some powerful, charismatic qualities.

These are known as the 5C's of a leader. A leader is a cool and clam person. He would not lose his temper instantly. Being a cool and calm personality there is no confusion. He possesses a clear vision that is a clear understanding, of what is he doing and why and how is he going to do it. This enables him to be confident and therefore he has a high level of commitment and while performing he becomes highly creative in his judge and assume what the other ways. This is how he becomes a source of inspiration. When he has these qualities there is job satisfaction or inner contentment that he derive from his own performance. So we can say that he experiences the charisma of contentment through his inner qualities.

A leader is effective and efficient due to certain attitudes and inherent abilities he has, which enables him to efficiently carry on his activities. There are eight main attitudes or inner powers that he exercises at the appropriate time and right place. There are some core values connected with these abilities and powers and when he becomes aware of them and practices living those values, then the abilities and powers are naturally developed.

The first ability or power that a leader needs to have is the listening ability or the power to withdraw. The secret of managing paradox lies in detachment and equanimity. The greater the ability to detach from the influence, and the ability to remain stable in any conditions, the greater is his abilities to manage the paradox. Therefore, it is very important for a leader to be able to withdraw and be a detached observer in order to hear what someone is trying to say. If he doesn't have the ability to pull back and observe he will immediately react,

one is saying on the basis of his very first impression. Before the other one has had the chance to complete what he is trying to say, he colours it with his own feelings and references. This is very dangerous, as leaders for correct information they receive. The basis for all the decisions is the information they take in. The ability to listen means a very effective and permanent survey and assessment of the situation.

It means having access to a very good management information system. In order to enhance the listening ability, one needs to have patience when someone is sharing something with him. If a manager is impatient, he loses relevant information and can hardly be successful without complete information.

The second ability that he has is mental availability or the power to pack up. The responsibility of a leader is to be present whenever and wherever he is needed. The listening ability and availability are very deeply connected. Whenever he is called upon, he needs to pack up all other thoughts, and pull out from whichever engagement his mind is busy in order to be fully available for the next. He needs to be available to those for whom he is responsible. Availability does not only mean

physical availability but together with physical availability. A leader has to be mentally available to his people. Thus, availability means more or mental freedom. Availability means to be always ready, so that you are able to start anything at any time. It means you have all means available to you to be able to delegate well to other competent persons for those jobs. If you can't delegate, you will be very busy and therefore not available. Availability means ability for decision making. Availability means to have very clear objectives. Why is he not available? He may be too objectives. Why is he not available? He may be too busy in doing a lot of other things which are not much important but very urgent or because he is not well organized. Further, he needs humility to be available to all his associates to gain trust of his people.
